



Gardens of Marrakech

The timeless city of Marrakech, which gave its name to Morocco, has an enduring appeal, with its low-rise pink and red buildings set against the magnificent backdrop of the snow-capped Atlas Mountains. Its beating heart is the square of Djemaa El Fna, where musicians and story-tellers and snake-charmers act out compelling scenes which have changed little over the centuries, and to which you will find yourself irresistibly drawn.

Day by day itinerary

Day 1 Fly from London Gatwick to Marrakech and following lunch, enjoy a guided walking tour of the city, with a visit to the Souk and the Koutoubia Mosque. Transfer to the Red Hotel Marrakech for a four-night stay. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 2 This morning, explore the Medina, with the Saadian Mausoleum and The Bahia Palace, and then the souks in the old town, before heading to Djemaa El Fna, the city's main square, where street musicians perform at every turn. After lunch, visit the Menara gardens and the Jardin Majorelle designed by the French artist Jacques Majorelle. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 3 After breakfast, we visit Ourika Valley, in the Atlas Mountains, stopping en route at the garden Anima. After lunch visit a Berber family at home and discover the way of life. Enjoy the decor and take a mint tea. Return to Marrakech. Dinner at the hotel or join our optional evening excursion to Djmaa El Fna night food market.

Day 4 This morning is a visit to Tom Smith's Secret Garden of Marrakech, one of the largest and most ancient palaces of the medina of Marrakesh comprising of two large gardens one exotic and one Islamic. After lunch, a visit to El Badia Palace and Dar Si Said Museum. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 5 Visit the Palmeraie Museum, set in manicured gardens, before transferring to Marrakech airport for the return flight to London Gatwick.
