Transport

Travelling by car: From the A41 Woodlands Roundabout, exit onto Aston Clinton Road, signposted as Aylesbury A41. Approximately 1 mile down the road exit left onto New Road at the Hotel and Golf Club road signs. Take the first left to the hotel entrance.

Travelling by train: The closest railway station is Aylesbury Train Station, which is 2.4 miles away from the hotel.

Waddesdon Manor

Waddesdon Manor is a grand Neo-Renaissance mansion built by Baron Ferdinand de Rothschild to display his art collection and entertain guests. Inspired by French châteaux, it features lavish interiors, including 18th century French furniture, fine paintings, and modern innovations of its era. Stowe Gardens

The scale and beauty of Stowe Gardens have attracted visitors for over 300 years. It is a renowned example of 18th-century Georgian landscape design, shaped by figures like William Kent and Capability Brown. Its winding paths, lakes, and classical temples were created to evoke harmony and philosophical ideals. Now cared for by the National Trust, the gardens remain a popular destination for their beauty and historical significance.

Ascott House

Ascott House presents as an 'Old English' manor house of black and white half-timber, with red tiled roofs and shafted brick chimneystacks. Its core is an old farmhouse thought to date from 1606. The original farmhouse has undergone many changes since being acquired by the Rothschild family in 1873. Ascott houses an exceptional collection of paintings, fine furniture and superb porcelain. Surrounded by 30 acres of gardens, it features fine art, French furniture, and oriental porcelain. Managed by the National Trust, it offers a peaceful retreat with a rich cultural legacy.
